

# A Day for Science Event Day Guide

**You are responsible for your own comfort and safety! Do not leave belongings unattended.**

**Getting to the event** – Familiarize yourself with the route for the [Infirmiry Duathlon](#), taking place beginning at 8am. It could impact traffic flow for people who are traveling downtown from the west. Old Shell Road and Dauphin Street are part of the bike route. Park within walking distance of Bienville Square.

**Dress comfortably** – The current forecast for the day is sunny with a high of 79 (the day will start cool, with a low in the mid-50s). Use sunscreen to protect exposed skin.

**Wear comfortable shoes** – If you attend the whole event, you will be on your feet for several hours. If you're going on the parade, the route is about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile.

**Bring a reusable water bottle** – We will have water coolers and cups available at our First Aid station.

**Family friendly** – Kids can complete a Future Scientist passport by visiting exhibitor tables to earn a pin.

**Think twice before bringing your pet** – If you MUST bring your pet along, make sure he is on a leash no longer than six feet, and be mindful of getting in close proximity with people or other animals. Be prepared to clean up pet waste. If your pet becomes disruptive or aggressive you may be asked to leave.

**Bring seating if you will need it** – This year we have only one keynote speaker, so we'll take no more than 30 minutes for that part of the event. If you anticipate needing to sit down during that time, you will need to bring your own seating, whether it's a chair or a blanket. We are not providing seating for the audience, although we may have a limited number of folding chairs we can use to accommodate a few people who need seats.

**If you require any accommodations for physical ability, please let us know as soon as you arrive!**

### During the parade:

- Follow the instructions of the City of Mobile Traffic Safety Officers.
- Stay with the group.
- If you have any problems, let one of the marshals know. We will have a First Aid volunteer on site.
